Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on September 12th 2013 at 7:00pm. Present were Mayor Mark Marshall, Councilman Mike Huseby, Joel Tremain and John Beightol. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell were also present. Attorney Ed Buchanan and Councilman Cameron McCoy were absent. Visitor attending was Tim Eisenhauer.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Joel moved to approve the minutes as read. John seconded, motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tracy gave a brief update on the sewer system and Cathy stated the State Revolving Loan Fund board meeting is in October. The LaGrange Heritage Square building was discussed. Joel moved to have Cameron order security cameras for the building. John seconded, motion carried. Cathy stated she visited with Ralph Robinson of Banner Medical. Their lease needs to go through budget then back to their legal department and Ralph would let us know as soon as he knows something.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Joel moved to approve Resolution #9-13 A Resolution Amending the Fiscal Year 12-13 Budget. Mike seconded, motion carried. Joel moved to approve the Arena Rough Stock Policy as read, John seconded, motion carried. Mike moved to approve the Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Policy, Joel seconded, motion carried. John moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance # 45A-4 Sewer Utility Rates with changes discussed, Mike seconded, motion carried. Title 1 of the town ordinances were discussed no action was taken at this time. After legal review Title 1 changes will be presented at the next council meeting for action and Title 2 will be discussed. A letter to the school district in regards to a broken fire hydrant was discussed no action was taken at this time. Clerk and Public Works questions were discussed no motions were made. Mike moved to pay the bills, John seconded, motion carried. John moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:34pm.

Minutes of the Public Hearing for the purpose of the application to the State Revolving Fund Loan Program, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on September 12th 2013 at 6:30pm. Present were Mayor Mark Marshall, Councilman Joel Tremain, Michael Huseby and John Beightol. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell were also present. Councilman Cameron McCoy was absent. There were no visitors attending.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 6:40pm. Mayor Marshall stated that the purpose of the public hearing was for the submission of a State Revolving Fund Loan in the amount of \$840,000.00. The loan and grant funds will be used to replace and repair damaged sewer lines. A sewer utility rate increase will be required in order to repay the debt. There were no questions and the public hearing was adjourned at 6:50pm.
