Minutes from May Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on May 10th 2018 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmen Joel Tremain, Mike Meysenburg and Mike Huseby. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell were also present. Councilman Ben Cline and Attorney Ed Buchanan were absent. Visitors attending were Nelson Miles and Marlon Giese.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Joel moved to approve the minutes with corrections. Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried.

Marlon Giese came to discuss a water and sewer line issue with the council. He gave the council some information he had gathered and proposed three options for compliance. After a lengthy discussion, no motions were made.

Nelson Miles came to discuss the work crew that will be coming to LaGrange over the summer. There will be about 16 motorhomes and they plan to stay on Frontier property. They will not need water or sewer hookups. After further discussion no actions were taken.

There being no further old business, Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Tracy discussed budget items. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the 2nd reading of budget ordinance #142. Mike Huseby seconded, motion carried. Clerk and public works questions were addressed, no motions were made. Mike Huseby moved to pay the bills, Joel seconded, motion carried. Mayor Marshall called an executive session to discuss property at 9:31pm. The regular meeting resumed at 10:00pm. Mike moved to adjourn the meeting at 10:16pm.

There will be a Public Hearing in conjunction with the Town Council Meeting, Thursday June 14th at 7:00pm to discuss and hear comments on the renewal of the Retail Liquor License. The Council meeting will begin immediately after the Public Hearing.



The water canon sprinkler will once again be available for anyone to play in-Tuesdays only at the baseball field.

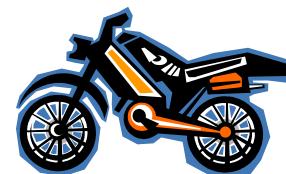
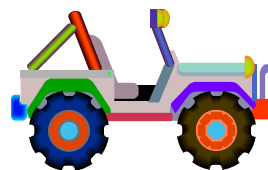

It's that time of year again to pay attention to **mosquito habitats**. They love standing water, so turn over buckets, tires, etc.-anything that holds water. If you have standing water and can't get rid of it, (horse or stock tanks, etc) please call Town Hall at 834-2466 for some mosquito brickets to place in the water- it will kill the larvae and not harm your livestock. A 2016 study done by Goshen County Weed & Pest showed a number of mosquitos testing positive for West Nile Virus in the LaGrange area. July and August are the highest population months for mosquitos, so be prepared in advance.
