### Minutes from March Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on March 14<sup>th</sup> 2024 at 6:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Huseby, Mike Meysenburg, Diane Humphrey and Kirk Haas. Assistant Clerk Cullene Clayton was also present. Attorney, Lena Moeller was also present. Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell were absent. There were numerous visitors in attendance.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 6:05pm. Diane Humphrey moved to approve the minutes as read. Kirk Haas seconded; motion carried.

Dalton Ward came on behalf of the Mini Fair Board to discuss the arena. After discussion, a motion was made by Mike Meysenburg to go into Executive Session following the regular meeting. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried.

Curtis Grandstaff came to inform the town that LaGrange Grain Co., LLC is planning to update the propane facility. They are talking with a company regarding new propane tanks. They will not let them be placed on the railroad right of way so they will have to be on their own property. This will probably take place in May or June if approved. He will let council know when Fire Marshall comes.

Curtis Grandstaff also came to discuss placing RV hook ups on property across from Town Hall.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. New shop plans were discussed: no updates.

The Goshen County Office of Emergency Management testing of outdoor warning sirens schedule will be in the April newsletter.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Kirk Haas moved to table the third reading of Ordinance #83 – Water until the next month meeting. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Boundary Permits were also discussed and also putting a copy of the complete permit in the newsletter.

Mike Meysenburg moved to pay the bills. Kirk Haas seconded; motion carried.

Meeting adjourned at 7:08pm. Mayor Marshall, Attorney Moeller and the councilmembers went into Executive Session. After the Executive Session ended Mayor Marshall called the meeting back to order. Diane Humphrey made a motion to approve a resolution stating any revenues received from use of arena will go back to the arena line item in the budget. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
