Minutes from October Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on October 11th 2018 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmen Joel Tremain, Ben Cline, Mike Meysenburg and Mike Huseby. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director, Tracy Pragnell were also present. Attorney Ed Buchanan was absent. There were no visitors attending.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:05pm. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the minutes with spelling corrections. Mike Huseby seconded, motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tracy gave updates on the sidewalk project.

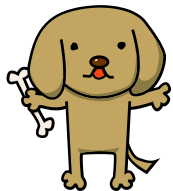

Mike Huseby moved to accept the offer from David Jingst to purchase a small section of land located at 625 3rd Ave for \$1. Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried. Ben moved to pay the bills, Mike Meysenburg seconded, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:24pm.

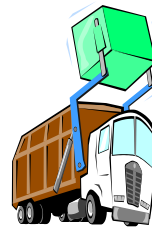
CHRISTMAS DECORATING CONTEST!

Reminder-Per Ordinance #31, Dog Tags Are Due January 1, 2018

Proof of rabies shots is required. Please get your animal to the vet, now if needed, for their rabies shots before January 1st. A \$25 fine per dog will be charged to those who do not purchase dog tags on time. The current dog tag rate is \$15.00 /dog. If you own a dog in the city limits, be sure to stop by the Town Hall and purchase your dog tags before January 1st, NO EXCEPTIONS! Town Ordinance #31 requires anyone having a dog in town limits to purchase an annual dog license by January 1st of each year. You may obtain a copy of the ordinance at the town hall office.



REMINDER

Please Do Not put ashes, hot or cold in the dumpsters.

LaGrange-Bear Creek Unity Association is offering grant money for community projects!

The LaGrange Community Endowment fund was established in 2009, started with donations to the Mrs. Archie (Kathy) Johnson memorial fund. This "designated" LaGrange Community Endowment Fund is invested as part of the Wyoming Community Foundation's portfolio with the earnings from this fund being disbursed annually to the LaGrange-Bear Creek Unity Association to address the priorities established by the Unity Board of Directors. Because it is an endowed fund, only the earnings are distributed to Unity, enabling the Fund to exist in perpetuity.

One of the priorities set forth by the LaGrange-Bear Creek Unity Association's Board of Directors is to distribute a portion of the earnings to nonprofit and service organizations within the LaGrange-Bear Creek community in the form of grants for projects that will enhance the quality of life in and for this community

If your nonprofit or service organization wishes to apply for this LaGrange community grant, read more about it on the Town of LaGrange Website on the Library page, or pick up a packet at Unity Library or at the LaGrange Town Hall. **The grant application deadline is November 1, 2018. The decision will be announced after January 21, 2019.**

Grant awards will be made based on the availability of endowment distributions from Wyoming Community Foundation. All decisions will be at the sole discretion of the Unity Board of Directors, and not necessarily on an annual basis. 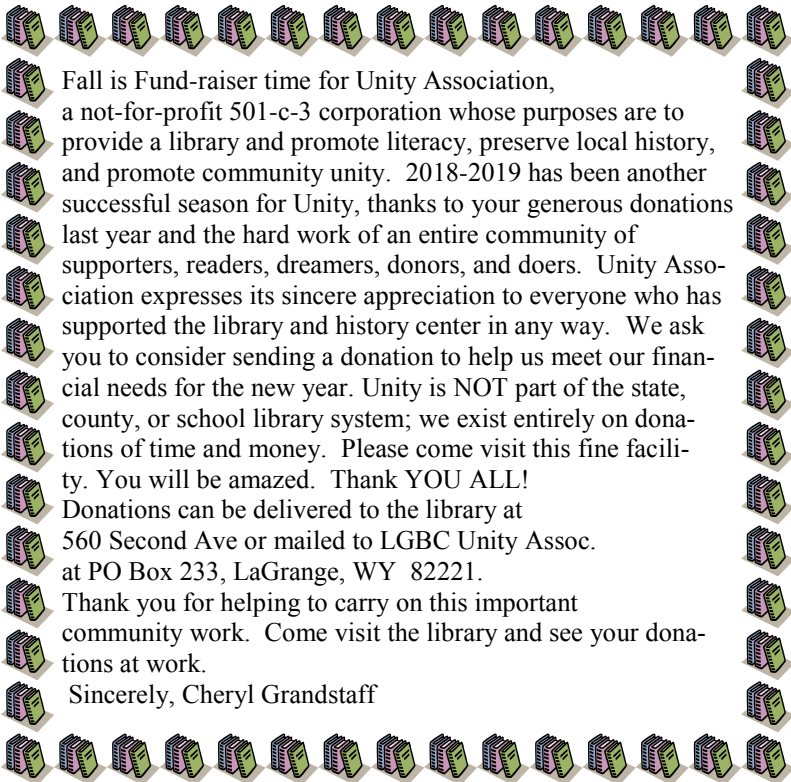
