Minutes from September Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on September 12th 2024 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall and Councilmembers Diane Humphrey, Mike Huseby and Kirk Haas. Councilmember Mike Meysenburg and Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell were absent. Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard was present. Visitors attending were; Tim Eisenhauer, Peggy Oedekoven, Robin Boyd, Robert Goodall, Jeff Sharp, Linnea Dix, Phil & Laura Gomes, Mike Vinton, Peter Davis and Ray Young.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Mike Huseby moved to approve the minutes as read. Diane Humphrey seconded; motion carried.

Tim Eisenhauer representing JEO Consulting discussed the bids for the public facilities project and gave the recommendation from JEO to proceed with Reichert Insulation & Construction, Inc. as low bidder for the project. Mike moved to approve the notice to proceed for Reichert Insulation & Construction, Inc. Kirk seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Cathy stated, as far as she knew, AVI Engineering has not returned the final draft for the second phase of the water study at this time.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Kirk moved to approve the attorney contract. Diane seconded; motion carried. Kirk moved to approve resolution #3-24 A Resolution Authorizing submission of a Mineral Royalty State Land & Investment Grant Application. Requesting \$500,000 of Mineral Royalty Funds from the Grant. Mike seconded; motion carried. Clerk questions were discussed, no motions were made. Mike Huseby stated Frontier School of the Bible would like to donate lighting and installation to the ball field as well as moving the back stop to a different location on the field. After further discussion, Kirk moved to approve the donation from Frontier School of the Bible to move the back stop to the southeast corner of the field and install lighting, including electrical, along the walk path and the eastside tree row. Diane seconded; motion carried. Mayor Marshall stated his concern for property owners' knowledge of boundary permit requirements, suggesting placing a permit in the next utility billing to remind property owners to complete a permit prior to building on their property. The permit is in place to help the property owners be sure they are on their own property as well as a reminder to call for utility locates prior to digging. This permit is free to the property owner. Kirk moved to pay the bills. Mike seconded; motion carried. Diane moved to adjourn at 8:42pm.

Boundary Permits

It is a requirement of the Town to submit a completed Boundary Permit Application prior to any construction, including fences.
