Minutes from April Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on April 10th 2025 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Huseby, Kirk Haas, Diane Humphrey and Mike Meysenburg. Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell were also present. Visitors attending were: Jeff & Brenda Sharp, Peggy Oedekoven, Daisy Justus, and Robin Boyd.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the minutes as read. Kirk seconded; motion carried.

Wyoming Child & Family Development representatives Deb Grandy and Jessia Rohrer joined via zoom. Jessica explained the benefits of WCFD to the community as well as Goshen County. After further questions and discussions, Mike Huseby moved to approve their request for \$200 support for the FY 25-26. Kirk seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tracy stated the applications for the water project grants will take a significant amount of time. He and Cathy are working on the applications and the different funding opportunities. Tracy discussed the progress on the public works facility. He gave an update on the funding and the change orders. Tracy suggested completing alternate #1 in house. Alt #1 is the heaters for the facility. After further discussion, Kirk moved to un-award alternate #1 for the project. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. The disconnect/reconnect fees were discussed as well as the RV hook ups. No motions were made. Mayor Marshall asked for discussion on the budget. There were no questions or changes.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Kirk moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance #84-Repealing Ordinance #50-Application for Boundary Permit. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Mike Huseby moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance#149 -Budget FY 25-26. Kirk seconded; motion carried. Diane moved to approve Resolution #4-25 Election Officials. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Clerk and public works questions were discussed. Tracy stated he would be at the water conference next week. He also stated the town clean-up will be April 25th 2025. Mike Huseby moved to pay the bills. Kirk seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:17pm.

PREAMBLE TO THE ALA CONSTITUTION

For God and Country, we associate ourselves together for the following purposes:

TO INCULCATE A SENSE OF INDIVIDUAL OBLIGATION TO THE COMMUNITY, STATE AND NATION..."

The individual is the basis of the American nation. Unlike other ideas of government, the American ideal places the individual first. The nation belongs to the individual, not the individual to the nation. The government exists for the purpose of serving the individual, not the individual for the purpose of serving the nation. If this ideal is to survive, there must be a voluntary sense of obligation of the individual to the nation and its component parts, the community and state. The American citizen serves his community, state and nation, not as a driven slave, but as a free man guided by his own sense of duty. To inculcate this feeling among all Americans is one of the great purposes of the Legion and Auxiliary.


