# Minutes from May Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on May 8<sup>th</sup> 2025 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Mark Marshall; Councilmembers Mike Huseby, Kirk Haas, Diane Humphrey and Mike Meysenburg. Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard and Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell were also present. Visitors attending were: Bruce Hale, Jennifer Pragnell, Peggy Oedekoven, Nathan & Daisy Justus, Tammy DiRienzo and Christy Marshall.

Mayor Marshall called the meeting to order at 7:01pm. Diane Humphrey moved to approve the minutes with correction. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried.

Mayor Marshall asked for old business. Tracy stated the water project will be a lengthy process. He and Cathy are working on researching applications and deadlines. Diane asked for an update from water conference. Tracy stated he was not able to attend due to our back up operators' family member passing. Tracy decided to cancel so he could be available in case of any water issues. He will need to attend some trainings in the fall. Tracy discussed the progress on the public works facility. He stated there was an issue with the trim and stated there will be a change order for additional metal to frame the windows all the same color rather than white. Tracy has been on site daily and the contractors have the roof complete and are working on framing this week. The disconnect/reconnect fees were discussed as well as the RV hook ups. No motions were made. Mayor Marshall asked for discussion on the budget. Cathy discussed a couple changes. Health insurance costs were increased and added to the wages in the budget and the sales tax revenues had changed and adjusted in the budget. Cathy stated we were approximately \$1000 over in revenue so she put the extra funds toward water expenditures. There was no further discussion.

Mayor Marshall asked for new business. Kirk Haas moved to approve the third and final reading of Ordinance#149 -Budget FY 25-26. Mike Huseby seconded; motion carried. Mike Meysenburg moved to approve the third and final reading of Ordinance #84- Repealing Ordinance #50-Application for Boundary Permit. Kirk seconded; motion carried. Mike Huseby moved to approve water and sewer permits for property located at block 22 lots 4, 5 and part of 6 of the original town. Kirk seconded; motion carried. Clerk and public works questions were discussed. Cathy suggested a workshop prior to next meeting to get new council members up to date on town business. A workshop will be scheduled for Tuesday June 10<sup>th</sup> at 3pm. Cathy stated the canvassing board is the current council and will meet immediately after votes are tallied from the election on May 13<sup>th</sup> 2025. She stated is usually takes 30-45 min for the tally but could take longer. Tracy stated there was water in the basement at the LHS building again. He is still assessing the issue and working with the school district on the issue. Tracy stated he will be spraying for mosquitos in the future and if anyone has questions to contact town hall. Diane Humphrey moved to pay the bills. Mike Meysenburg seconded; motion carried. Mayor Marshall stated how grateful he was to have been able to have the opportunity to represent LaGrange. He thanked everyone and stated his request, to the new council, to keep moving forward on items to work on in the future. Meeting adjourned at 8:06pm.

Minutes of the Canvassing Board, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on May 13<sup>th</sup> 2025 at 8:16pm. Present were Mayor Mark Marshall, Councilman Kirk Haas, Mike Meysenburg and Diane Humphrey. Councilman Mike Huseby was absent. Town Clerk Cathy Stoddard was also present.
