

Minutes from June Town Council Meeting

Minutes of the Regular Meeting, Town of LaGrange, Wyoming, meeting at the Town Hall on June 12th 2025 at 7:00pm. Present were: Mayor Kirk Haas; Councilmembers, John Goold & Tracy May. Town Clerk, Cathy Stoddard was also present. Councilman Mike Huseby and Public Works Director Tracy Pragnell were absent. There were several visitors in attendance.

Mayor Haas called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. He began by welcoming the new council members. Mayor Haas appointed Cathy Stoddard as town Clerk/Treasurer and Tracy Pragnell as town Public Works Director. John moved to approve the minutes of the May 8th canvassing board minutes. Tracy May seconded; motion carried. Tracy May moved to approve the May 13th regular town council meeting minutes. John seconded; motion carried.

Mark Davidson and CJ Walker from Sunrise Engineering came to introduce themselves and stated they would like to get to know the LaGrange community more and hoped to work with the town in the future. They stated they were familiar with the towns water studies and have been working with Manville, currently, on a water project.

Lora Gomes came representing the LaGrange Mini Fair. She invited the new council to participate in the parade in carriages that would be provided. She requested the use of the town grills, picnic tables, 5-7 safety cones and assistance to hang a Mini Fair sign they had purchased. Mayor Haas stated the picnic tables will be at the park and the grills & cones will be set out Friday the 20th. He stated he would need to discuss the hanging of the banner with Tracy Pragnell before he could answer that request. There was discussion about working the arena and mowing the grounds. It was stated the arena had been worked a couple times and will be worked one more time next week. Lora requested ambulance services for the day and was referred to the LaGrange Volunteer Fire Department and EMS. Watering the area was discussed and that was also referred to the Volunteer Fire Department or District. Lora stated she would ask about the water when she asks about the ambulance services.

Mayor Haas asked for old business. He gave a brief description of the water project to the new council and visitors. He stated the water project construction phase is in the application process still and it will be a lengthy process. Mayor Haas gave an update on the progress of the public works facility. He stated the completion date is July 10th but we are not sure the contractors will meet that deadline. Mayor Haas explained to the new council members the previous council had been working on an RV ordinance for a while and we need to finish that up. He stated he would like to have the new members take the information and table the discussion for July meeting so the new members are more prepared and Mike Huseby could be in attendance.

Mayor Haas asked for new business. He stated we have appointed a mayor pro tem in the past and would like to do so again. John moved to appoint Mike Huseby as mayor pro tem. Tracy May seconded, motion carried. After a lengthy discussion, John moved to appoint Jennifer Pragnell to the vacant council seat for the remainder of the term. Tracy May seconded; motion carried. Mayor Haas stated he had been contacted by Police Chief Johnson from Torrington to sign a letter of support for a Safe Streets and Roads Action Plan Grant. After further discussion, it was decided to send a letter of support. Clerk questions were discussed. John moved to support Mini Fair with parade prize funds in the amount of \$200 again this year. Tracy May seconded, motion carried. Tracy May moved to pay the bills. John seconded; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:22pm.
